CHURCH PLANTING

We first heard the term "church planting" in 2006 while attending Trinity Bible College and immediately sensed passion and calling, knowing one day we would be church planters.

In the 14 years since, every ministry and life experience has been preparing and pointing us in this direction. We believe that the inescapable burden to plant a church has finally found its place to call home - Alaska. Our experiences, personalities, and temperaments make us a great fit for church planting and Alaska.

We have been part of a church planting team in Wisconsin, founded multiple church ministries, been business owners and have an extensive network of experienced church planters to learn from. When we drive by buildings-for-lease our very first thought is, "I think we could do church in there!" We were created to build healthy, spirit-filled churches that transform lives and alter destinies.

ALASKA

Nearly 10 years ago, realizing the difficult nature of ministry (and in remote places) we began praying for Alaska AG churches to find pastors (relying on the open church list). That habitual practice has grown into a full-blown calling. We consume as much Alaska as we can, from watching all the Alaska-based tv shows, owning two Siberian Huskies, and watching random YouTube videos of travel and life in AK. After our August 2019 vacation to AK, we have moved beyond the excitement phase about living there, to the confident expectation that Alaska is calling us home!

WHY A NEW CHURCH?

OUR DREAM FOR ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, AND BEYOND

Alaska has been both a dream-destination and a labor of prayerful destiny. What started off as a "man it would be cool to live there" has turned into "I can't imagine God calling us to serve people in any other location on earth."

Our ultimate dream for Anchorage, the state of Alaska, and beyond is to play a role in seeing transformational life-change in every person of every nation and in every generation. A significant part of this process will be our vision to create a church that starts several churches ... or a "church-planting church." We believe God is building His church and multiplying it!

Anchorage, AK

Anchorage is a fast-growing urban center of over 380,000 people surrounded by endless mountains, rivers, lakes, and an ocean inlet. The people who live here are diverse in many ways - ethnicity, economics, religious beliefs, life stage, and age ranges. It is home to some of the nation's leading oil industry companies, is an international commercial airport hub, station to a joint military base, the largest of the University of Alaska school system campuses, and quite literally the heartbeat of all Alaska. It is a city with access to wilderness and metropolitan atmospheres. Its people are strong, driven, and resourceful. Jesus loves Anchorage and He is building His church.

THE NEED

250,000 claim no religious affiliation

- In census data from 2010, **68%** of the population claimed "no religious affiliation". With a population of **380,821**, this means roughly **250,000** people are disconnected from an abundant life in Jesus.
- There are a total of 442 religious congregations (all faiths) with only **8 Assembly of God churches** in Anchorage, 2 of which are located on the south side of the city Legacy Church will be launched in south Anchorage.
- 2009 the last time a Network-Affiliated Assembly of God church was planted in Alaska. We will be adding several new churches over the next several years. We believe the good news about Jesus is most effectively shared by the launching of new churches.
- Crime rates for assault, sexual assault, and burglary in Anchorage are among the highest in the nation.
- Homelessness is a rapidly growing issues with little to no longterm solutions available.

VISION BASICS

Mission: Leading people in a growing relationship with Jesus

Vision: Transforming the lives of 5,000 people in 10 years by **Experiencing God**, **Making God Known**, **Developing People**, **Launching New Churches**, and **Serving the City**.

EXPERIENCING GOD

We will create environments where people can experience God's presence and respond to the gospel's call of salvation and transformation. This includes a corporate worship style marked by celebration, energy, reverence, Biblical integrity, and prayer.

MAKING GOD KNOWN

We will make every effort to be as simple and creative as possible to tell people about Jesus and invite them into the life of God. Special attention will be given to encouraging and equipping people to share the good news on a personal level, as well as event based evangelistic efforts.

DEVELOPING PEOPLE

Relationships within small groups will be the driving force and DNA of Legacy Church. We will provide people the opportunity to develop as followers of Jesus who are marked by faith, obedience to God, Bible knowledge and engagement, prayer, worship, generosity, serving people, leading people, and sharing the good news of Jesus.

LAUNCHING CHURCHES

We believe that new churches are one of the best ways to spread the good news of Jesus. From the very beginning we will set a course to be a church that launches new churches. Multiplication will be part of who we are and what we do. Our goal is to launch one church every three years.

SERVING THE CITY

We will partner with and work alongside the city of Anchorage to meet the needs of its citizens. This means providing volunteers for city-operated events, creating new ministry where none exists, assisting current non-profit organizations with their efforts, and collaborating with other churches to serve the city.

CMN has the vision of seeing a "healthy, Spirit-empowered church in every of city of the United States."

CMN has provided us church planter training at their event in Sept 2020 in Seattle, WA. We not only received industry-leading training, but were connected with an experienced church planter who continues to cheer us on and coach us from a distance.

Through our training, relationship and coaching with CMN, we will be applying for CMN Matching Funds - they will match up to \$50,000 of what we generate from fundraising.



The General Presbytery of the Alaska Ministry Network approved the decision for us to start a brand new church in Anchorage, Alaska - the first new Network Affiliated church to start since 2009! We will be working side-by-side with each other in creating a healthy, Spirit-filled church.
